APPLICATION PROCESS:

Applicants must complete application packet and include the following:

- Spotlight on Leadership application (preferably typed).
- One-page essay, double-spaced as follows: Share an experience from which you learned the most about being a leader.
- Résumé, which includes leadership experience, special leadership programs attended, employment, and community service involvement.
- Two letters of recommendation –
 - One from a high school administrator, counselor, or teacher
 - One from a supervisor of leadership activity
- Return completed application to the Counseling Department; they will submit all applications to the address below.
